Bountiful Plans for Learning This Quarter

Now that the quarter is over, we will be beginning new units for several subjects. We are reading about teamwork in our reading/language arts unit. We will discover the new world in our Age of Explorers Unit in History and travel back in time to the Spice Islands and trade routes of the Middle Ages . We are examining the scientific theories of the universe proposed by the earliest European scientists and astronomers. Your student may share the Geocentric and Helioc entric theories of the origins and workings of the solar system with you. Book reports were due today. Students will be having a book report due every two or three weeks.

Students have not been turning in their short paragraphs on what they have read, so to insure they are reading, we will begin a longer term project of book reports due on frequent intervals.

Math seems to always be a favorite subject for this class. We will be building on prior knowledge to learn new concepts and more difficult algorithms as the weeks progress.
